The English Philology Department at Vasyl Stefanyk Precarpathian National University (Ivano-Frankivsk, Ukraine) is pleased to invite young researchers to participate in the 8th Student Academic Conference “**Exploring Linguistics, Literature, and Intercultural Communication**”, which will be held **online on 10 October 2023**.

ELLIC 2023 aims to foster collaboration among young researchers in a variety of academic disciplines and theoretical approaches, providing a platform for the exchange of research findings and the dissemination of pertinent knowledge. While the conference primarily focuses on linguistics, literary studies, translation studies, and intercultural communication, we anticipate engaging discussions about presentations from other related disciplines.

The conference covers a wide range of topics, including but not limited to the following:

- The semantics and pragmatics of language units and text/discourse.**
- Cognitive linguistics and cognitive poetics.**
- Stylistics and literary studies.**
- Comparative linguistic studies and intercultural communication.**
- Current issues in translation studies.**

The conference will feature plenary sessions and section presentations as online events. We welcome contributions from PhD students as well.

The languages of the conference are English, German, French, and Ukrainian.

Prospective authors are invited to submit their abstracts for review and publication in the conference proceedings (Proceedings of the 8th Student Academic Conference “Exploring Linguistics, Literature, and Intercultural Communication”, ISBN 978-966-640-543-5). Papers will be available on the website: <https://kaf.pnu.edu.ua/>.

Please submit your abstract in English, German, French, or Ukrainian via e-mail to kaf@pnu.edu.ua, and indicate the applicant’s name (e.g. Davydiuk_abstract.doc). The deadline for abstract submission: **23 October 2023**.

Guidelines for Authors (see the sample below):

- Abstracts should not exceed 500 words (excluding examples and references).
- Text should be formatted using Microsoft Office Word (*.doc / *.rtf).
- Font: Arial.
- Title of the abstract: 12 pt bold, in capital letters, centre alignment.
- Name, surname, affiliation, city, and country: 14 pt, centre alignment.
- Main text: 12 pt, with a single line of indentation, and line spacing set to 1.
- Page size: A4, portrait orientation.
- Margins: top, bottom, left, right – 2 cm, paragraph indent – 5 spaces (0.8 cm).
- Graphics, pictures, and tables should not exceed the specified page margins.

The font size can be reduced to 10 pt, with no indentations.

All page references should be included in the text within parentheses after the quotation. This should include the number of the source followed by a colon, and then the page number. For example: (Stockwell 2007: 87). Sources should be provided at the end under the heading “References” in alphabetical order (12 pt).
